ABOUT THE COVER:

In Greek, the word ΙΧΘΥΣ (pronounced "ikthus") means *fish*. The fish is one of the oldest symbols for Christ, and was used by the early Christians as a secret sign. As the cover design indicates, in Greek, the letters Ι-X-Θ-U-S form an acrostic which works out to read, "Jesus Christ, Son of God, Saviour".
